We are pleased to present issue number 38 of the *Comunicación y Medios Magazine* which includes a *Monograph* with nine articles on the topic: *Communication and Spatiality*, edited by guest professors: Lorena Antezana (University of Chile) and Marcela Rosales (National University of Cordoba Argentina). In addition this particular number includes a section titled *Miscellaneous*, a collection of five articles dealing with other topics of interest referring to social communication, and, the habitual space reserved for *Reviews*.

It is also relevant to mention that *Comunicación y Medios* has passed the assessment phase for inscription into the scientific electronic library SciELO Chile, an international Project developed by the National Commission for Scientific and Technological Research (CONICYT). From issue number 37 onward all articles and reviews will be made available

through this important academic distribution network. This implies significant recognition of our publication, which was already indexed in networks, databases and repositories such as Latindex, Dialnet, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Latin American quotes in Social Sciences and Humanities (CLASE), Data Matrix for Magazine Analysis (MIAR), Google scholar, Iberian American Network for Innovation and Scientific Knowledge (REDIB), European Reference Index for the Humanities and Social Sciences (ErihPlus) and the Emerging

Sources Citation Index (ESCI) of Clarivete Analytics (WoS, ex-ISI).

Reaching this benchmark binds and commits us to improving on the quality, design, visibility and international distribution of the magazine, using it to build a platform for academic discussion, and the dissemination of the science of communication.

The next issue (39, due for publication in July

2019) will continue with the trend of continuously receiving articles on communication for the *Miscellaneous* section, and proposes the following for the *Monograph* section: "Documentary and fiction in contemporary Latin American cinema: borders and transit", which will be edited by professors Catalina Donoso (University of Chile) and Valeria de los Ríos (Pontific Catholic University of Chile).

Lastly, the magazine's Editorial Committee

wishes to thank the assessors, editors, external editors, authors and readers for all their support. We also extend a heartfelt thanks to the Institute for Communication and Image at the University of Chile for their work as the editing institution.
